## OTARI SCHOOL ENROLMENT, TERM 4 2019 – TERM 2 2020

Otari School Board of Trustees is limited in the number of places it is able to offer students as a consequence of operating an enrolment scheme, details of which are available at the school office or on our website.

The Board has determined that there are limited spaces available in the **Montessori Strand** for students who will be **Year 1 students in 2020** (turning 5 between 1 July 2019 and 30 June 2020).

For out of zone students seeking enrolment at Otari School the deadline for receipt of applications is **Friday 30 August**. Applicants will be notified of the outcome of applications on or before **Friday 6 September 2019**.

If the number of out of zone applicants exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot following the Ministry of Education defined priority order. If a ballot for out of zone places is required it will be held on **Monday 2 September.** Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within five days of it being held.

Ballot date: Monday 2 September

Applicants notified: On or before Friday 6 September
