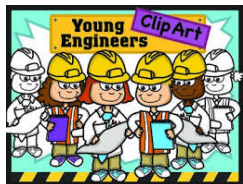

Ōtari EPro8 Challenge 2023 - Over 50 senior students immersed themselves in science, engineering, physics and maths to solve problems in Ōtari School's EPro8 Challenge. The challenge ran in two age bands: Year 5 to 6 working with Whaea Erana and Year 7 to 8 with Deborah.

On the first day, students learned about the EPro8 construction equipment, completing introduction tutorials, including learning to work with gears. We finished off the day by completing a challenge as a taster for Day 2.

The second day was the Ōtari EPro8 Problem Challenge! Teams of four competed over two intense hours, working together to solve three challenges for points, constructing functioning wells, a 'dunk the teacher' fair attraction and an automatic certificate machine. Congratulations to all who participated!

The Year 5 to 6 competition ended in a draw for first place, so these two teams will head to the EPro8 inter-school competition. The winning team from the Year 7 to 8 competition automatically qualified for the next round and a team selected from remaining competitors will make up the second team. The next round will be at South Wellington Intermediate in Week 1 of Term 4.
