## Kia ora koutou



This week, we are most fortunate to have Ruud Kleinpaste, 'The Bugman' visiting our school. He has been working with classes as they study bugs. His enthusiasm has motivated the children and his expertise has ensured rich learning has occurred. Unfortunately, tonight's planned visit into the Otari bush with the Yr 7/8 students has been cancelled, due to forecasted high winds and rain.

Next week, we have 'Mike the Forager' (Mike King) visiting the school. Mike will be working with classes to explore the unique flavours growing on plants all around us.

**Children coming back to school after hometime** - Some children are returning to school soon after going home at the end of the school day. They are unsupervised. This is not an issue at the weekend or in summer when after school care is over, but it does cause problems at other times. The Otari After School Care personnel should not be having to deal with conflicts that arise due to interaction between the children they are responsible for and children who are



unsupervised. After School Care workers already have multiple responsibilities. When school is over children should either go home or be in after school care, unless they are staying to play in the playground **under the supervision of an adult.**
