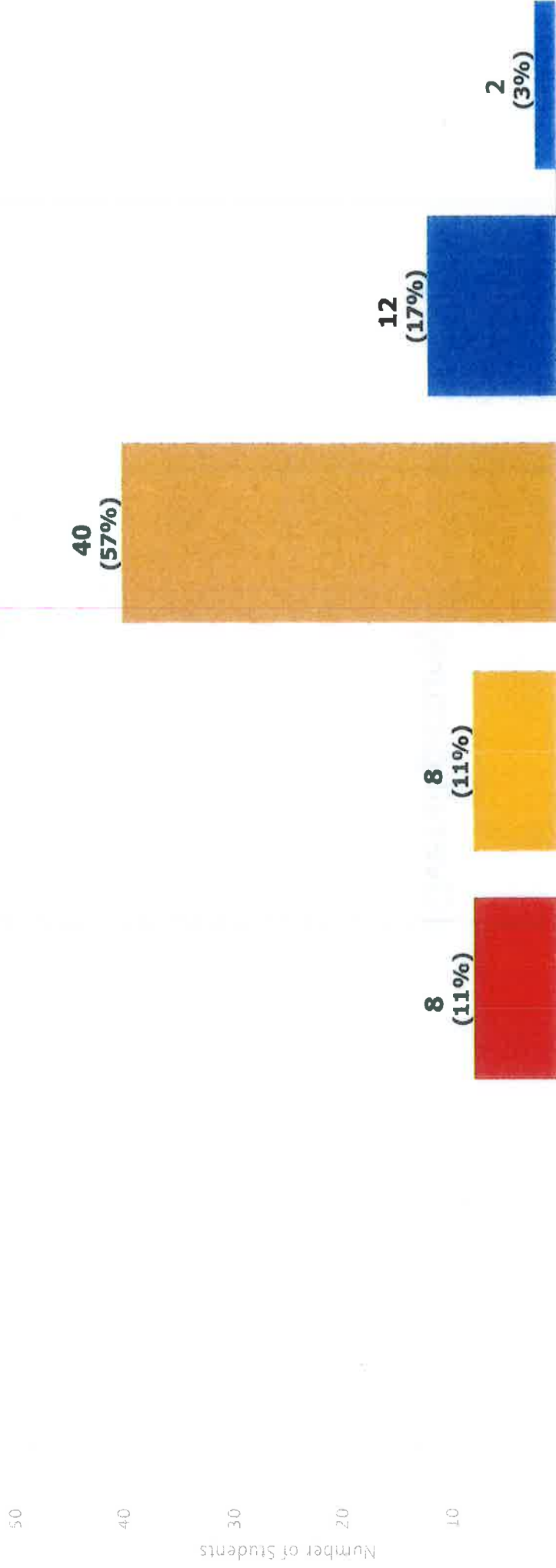

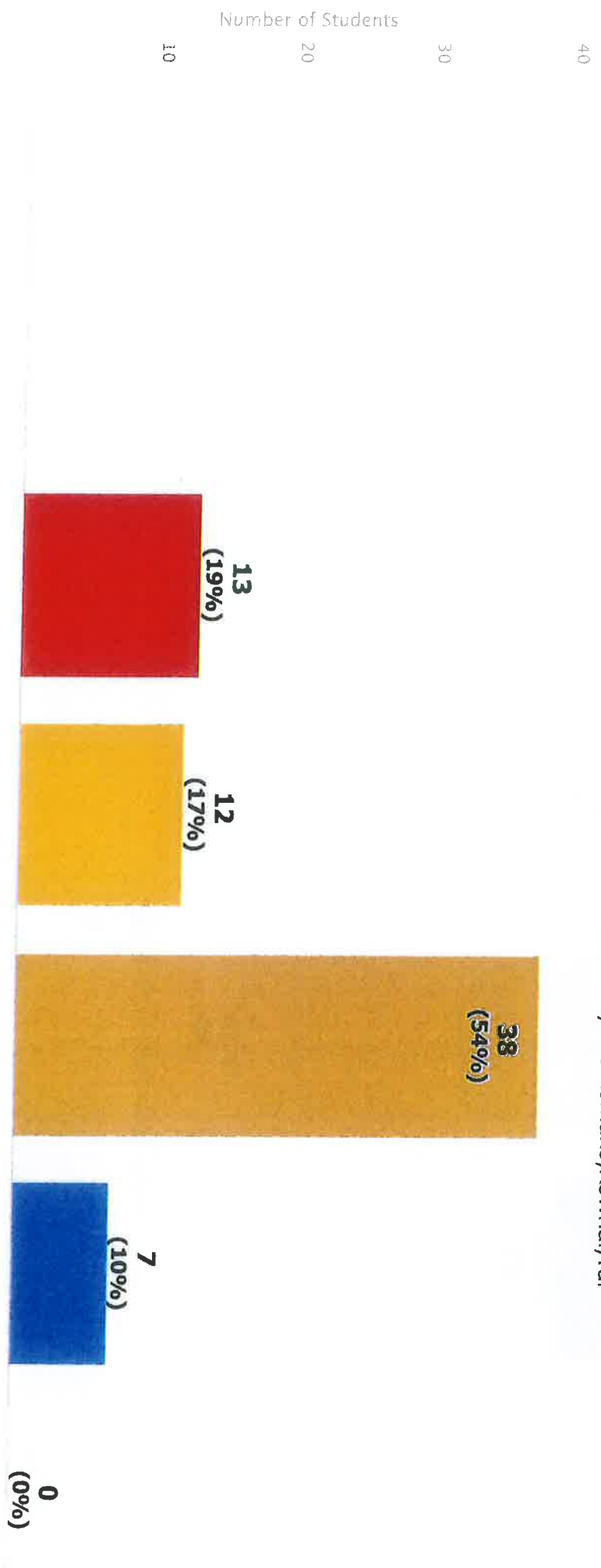

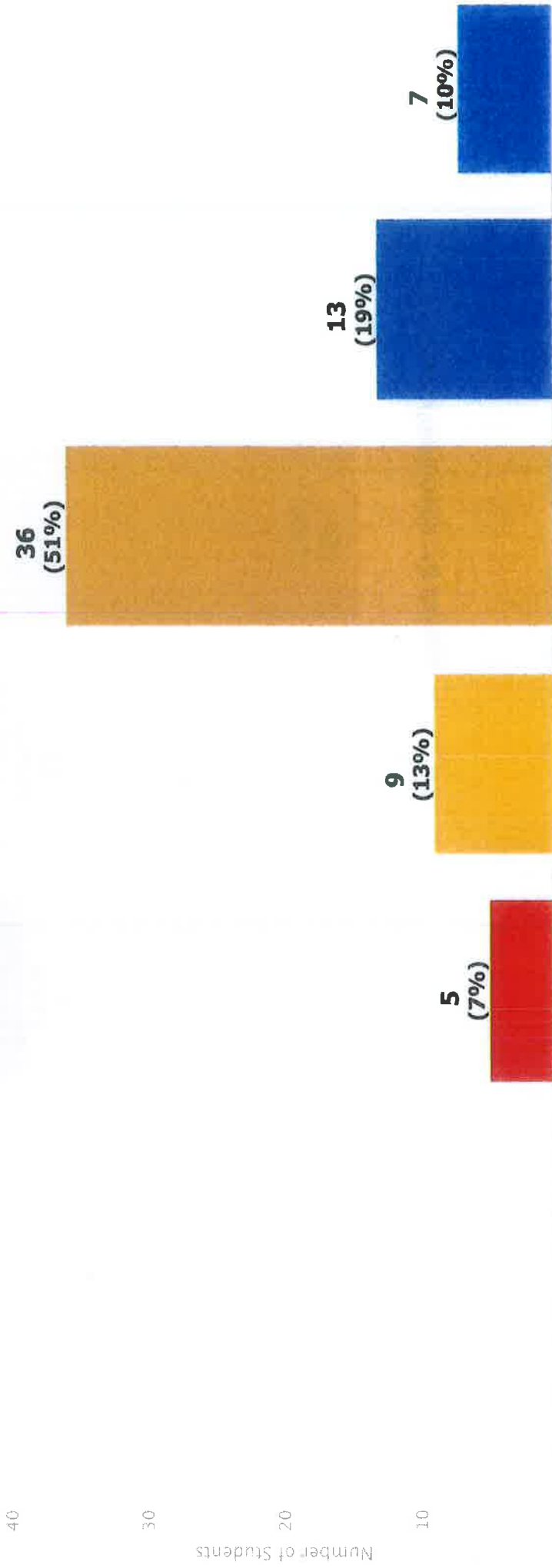

Math Term 4 - 2023 - Column Chart

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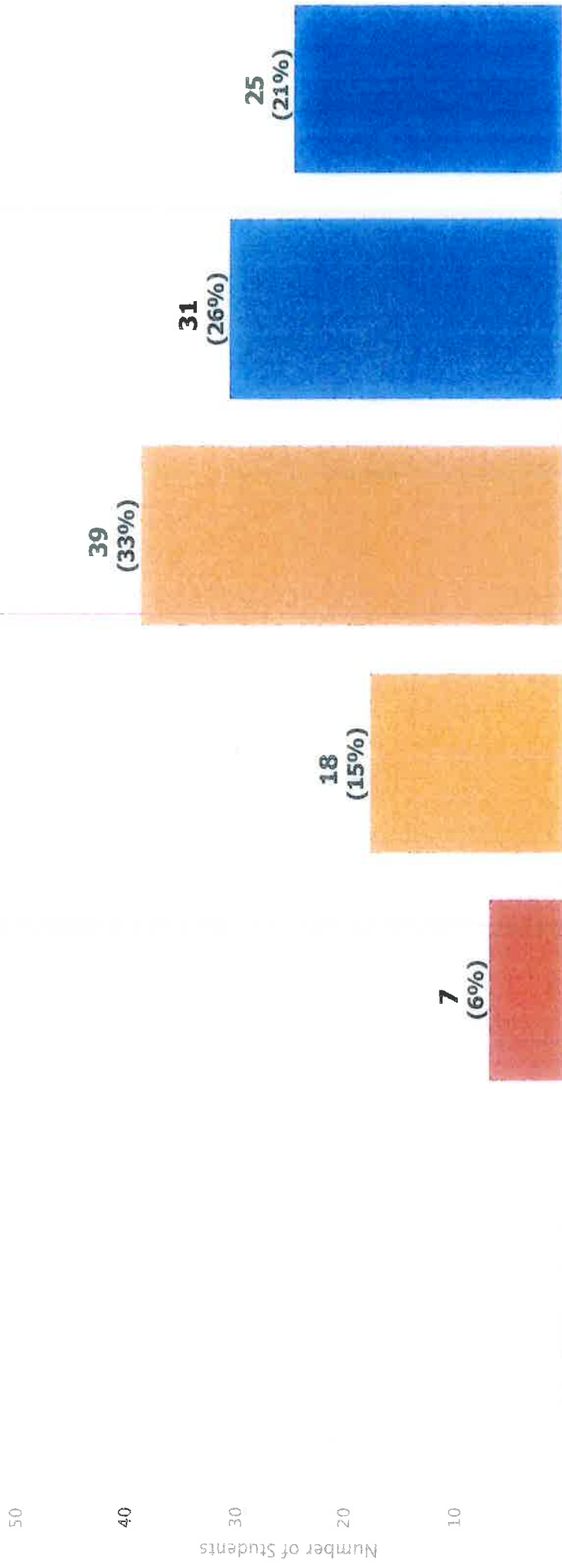


Māori Medium end of year OTJ results 2023

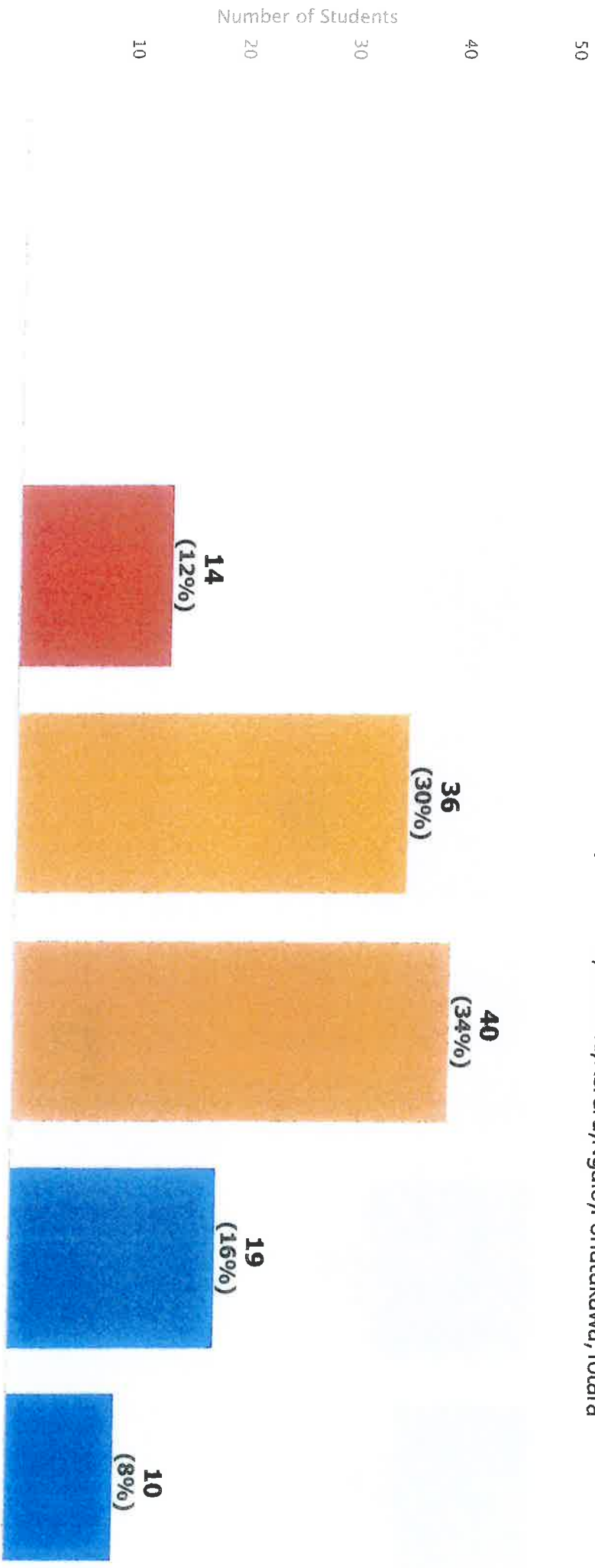

Comparison to TERM 2 2023 results

ENGLISH MEDIUM percentage at or above expectation

Reading	72%	80%	76%
Writing	53%	58%	64%
Mathematics	63%	74%	68%

MĀORI MEDIUM percentage at or above expectation

Learning Area	T2	T4	2022
Pānui	77%	77%	75%
Tuhituhi	69%	64%	60%
Pāngarau	62%	80%	62%

The gains in mathematics/pāngarau are pleasing. In the whenu Māori strand particularly this may reflect the significant professional development that the strand received last year in this area.

Writing remains a focus for lifting achievement. In this area there is a significant number of students who are just below (eg, early L4 rather than mid L4). There is also a significant number of students with dyslexia.

In the Montessori strand many children start school at or close to 6 years old. The “expectation” is based on having received a year of primary school education. Seven out of nine year 1 and 2 children are not writing at expectation yet, but will likely be within the next year or so.
