Tomorrow, via email, you will receive our Otari School Covid-19 Response Plan. This has been approved by the Board of Trustees. The overall plan contains a **Safety Plan** that explains how we currently operate under Red Level and a **Response Plan** for the range of situations we may be faced with over the coming weeks or months.



Though comprehensive, the information is focussed on the greatest risks, therefore every possible scenario might not be covered. The plan provides the steps and guidelines within which we will operate and clarity in relation to the responses we will all need to be part of. However, it is not set in concrete and needs to be fluid due to the unpredictable aspects of this situation. Please read it thoroughly with this in mind.

The Safety Plan only covers the current Red level. You will be notified about how we operate under Orange when the time comes. The plan will also be put on our school website.
