Notification – Please would you continue to inform the school if your child develops Covid, especially if they have been isolating, but had not previously tested positive. We are required to keep the Ministry of Education up-to-date.

Clarifying 7 Days Isolation - A unite against Covid-19 chart states that day 0 is the day you test positive or start experiencing symptoms - whichever is earliest. At Otari School, for the sake of clarity and consistency, we ask that children be kept home for 7 days **after** a positive test, not from the first sign of symptoms, with day 0 being the day they test positive.
