Parent Donations - You may have heard about the government policy of providing \$150.00 per child for all decile 1 to 7 schools, in place of the school requesting a donation. We are a decile 9 school therefore do not qualify for this, which I think is disappointing. It makes a presumption about our community and their ability to provide funding that is not borne out in reality. Between 60% and 70% of our parent community pay their donations. If we were part of the government scheme we would likely receive about \$10,000 more than we do. There are many ways our parents support us, often with time, transport and involvement in classroom projects or fundraising activities. This is all appreciated and we are aware that our task of educating the tamariki is enhanced by parental support and involvement. We would also not be able to make ends meet without the parent donation. A big thank you to all those who have contributed. We wish we were able to say you never needed to again, but as a decile 9 school we will still be relying on this in the future. Please consider contributing if you have not already done so.
