This year each strand's parent group is responsible for organising one whole school event on behalf of the parent committee. At the moment, whānau from the Māori Immersion Strand are organising an evening on 25 June for the celebration of Matariki.

SNUP - **School Network Upgrade** - Throughout the country, over the past decade, schools have been having their networks upgraded. Our school's network upgrade begins today and should be completed within the fortnight. This will improve our speed and utilisation of internet throughout the school.

2015 School Production - This year our school musical production is "The Pied Piper." There are a number of roles for senior (Yr 6-8) children to audition for as well as the opportunity to be part of the chorus/townspeople. We have been reinforcing to the children that every role, no matter how small is important for the success of a show. We have told the children that should they choose to audition, they must be prepared to be part of the whole show, whether in a major or minor role. Children also have the opportunity to build the set or be stagehands. The production will be taking place in week 9 of term 3, with performances on three nights (Tuesday 15th to Thursday 17th) and a matinee on the Wednesday.
